Last month Ganbina hosted its 19<sup>th</sup> annual Ganbina Youth Achievement Awards. A record 251 people attended, making it the largest awards night ever. The awards is open to all Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children and youth (Year 7- age 25) living in the Goulburn Valley and recognises achievement in education, training or employment.

The night opened with a Welcome to Country in traditional Yorta Yorta language by local Djeta Merle Miller. The guests were then treated to a traditional dance by the Kalithaban Dancers, which included the amazingly talented didge player Wilfred Stewart, alongside lead dancer Tristen Miller and Kailem Harrison, who are both Ganbina program graduates.

# **Q&A- Meet Ganbina Scholarship Program Project Officer** Klarindah Hudson

Hi Klarindah – welcome to Ganbina! Can you start with letting us know about yourself? Are you originally from Shepparton? What's your mob?

I grew up in Melbourne and moved to Shepparton in 2020, which was good timing because the lockdowns were so much more intense in the city than here. It was perfect timing.

Coming Up - Youth Leadership Program 2024 and Year 10 Leadership Trip to Camp Jungai



All Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander youth in the Goulburn Valley in Year 10 will have the opportunity to have a taste tester of the Ganbina Youth Leadership Program at a four day, three night leadership camp to Camp Jungai set in the scenic Rubicon Valley.

This is the second leadership camp to Camp Jungai Ganbina has run and will include activities that teach participants about team building, leadership and personal development. There will also be several cultural experiences with an Elder. These activities and teachings serve as a taste test of the skills and experiences that are included in the Youth Leadership Program.

The camp will run from Sunday, December 17th until Wednesday, December 20th. Please note that registrations for this year's Camp Jungai have now closed.

Next year the Ganbina Youth Leadership Program will be reduced from a three year to a one year program for Year 11 Ganbina participants who are enrolled in Ganbina's Jobs4U2 Education program. The program will include three trips in 2024, one to Melbourne or Sydney (exact destination to be confirmed), an interstate trip to Cairns and a final international trip to New Zealand.

Applications for the 2024 Youth Leadership Program will open in early February 2024 to students who will be enrolled in Year 11 in 2024 and Ganbina's Jobs4U2 Education Program.
