


At Ganbina, we believe education is the key to unlocking success in both training and employment.

The focus is on three essential life areas: Education, Employment, and Training, to ensure the next generation has the education, skills, and confidence to unlock their full potential.



Jobs4U2 Education focuses on ensuring our participants remain in mainstream education and understand the connection between education, career choices, and life opportunities.

We work to support and empower our participants to stay in school and graduate Year 12, as well as create a career employment vision, which links to their educational aspirations.



Jobs4U2 Employment aims to help youth turn the vision for their career employment path, established during the Jobs4U2 Education program, into a reality.

We work to support participants to obtain a job of their choice and progress through the workforce to the best of their abilities.



Jobs4U2 Training enables our young people to develop workplace readiness, skills or further education required to obtain the career of their choice.

We work to specifically engage youth in further education, e.g., TAFE, university, and vocational study, post-Year 12 graduation, and linking training with employment and career aspirations.

Spotlight Accelerated Learning Program

The Accelerated Learning Programs is designed to support Ganbina participants reach their full potential. Through this program offers participants opportunity to achieve their educational goals and excel academically.

The Accelerated Learning Program (Internal) has been designed to further assist Ganbina participants registered in the Education Program in Grades 3–6.

Core subjects such as English and Maths are delivered in a comfortable, inclusive environment with a student/tutor ratio kept to a minimum. Cultural elements and life skills are woven into the lesson plans to ensure that the students see the practical benefits of learning.

Accelerated Learning Program (External) is extended to General Education Program participants attending secondary school. This program is delivered by third-party providers with costs covered by Ganbina. This funding is additional to allocated scholarship funds.
