Welcome to the first Partner Update for the year. As a valued partner and supporter of Ganbina, we periodically send updates to our supporters to keep you across what has been happening within our organisation.

I am very pleased to announce that after four years Ganbina has officially opened a Queensland office. This is the first Ganbina office outside of Victoria and will allow us to further expand our program to other Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities.

Once we knew we had a model that worked, we knew we did not want to keep this program to ourselves. We want to share our learnings with other communities, so they could benefit from the impact our model has had on Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children and youth in the Goulburn Valley.

Being able to open a Brisbane office is a testament to not only the hard work of my team, but also the support and belief our supporters have had in myself as leader and the vision to expand Ganbina's model around the country.

In this newsletter we have included more information about our Brisbane office opening, along with a Q&A with our first Brisbane hire Kelly Hansen, who has joined the Ganbina Brisbane team as a Project Manager.

In our head office our annual Careers Night is coming up on May 1st. We are always on the lookout for businesses and further education providers to exhibit on the night. It is a great opportunity for your organisation to get in front of the next generation of

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander youth.

Ganbina openes its first Queensland office!

It's been four years in the making, but today we can officially announce the Ganbina Brisbane office has opened.

The opening of the Brisbane office is an extension of Ganbina's expansion into Queensland, which began in 2018 thanks to the support of the Morris Family Foundation. This support resulted in elements of the Jobs4U2 model operating at Ignatius Park College in Townsville and Port Curtis Coral Coast Trust in Bundaberg.

In 2019, 100 per cent of the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Year 12 students enrolled in the Townsville program obtained their Year 12 certificate. In Bundaberg, we were able to assist Port Curtis Coral Coast Trust to offer scholarships and Accelerated Learning program elements to Bundaberg's Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children and youth.
